Student Regulations
Governing Driving to School

Students will have an opportunity to drive to school and must understand and abide by all regulations developed for Airport High School.

A Student driving to school must:

- Within three weeks from the start of school, register the vehicle that is to be driven to school.
- Pay the registration fee of \$20.00.
- Drive carefully at all times including all evening events.
- Have the vehicle properly licensed and insured.
- Have in his/her possession a valid driver's license.
- Be a sophomore, junior or senior at Airport High School. *Freshman are not allowed to drive.*
- Follow the direction of all posted signs.
- Park in the student parking section only (Shown on the back of this form).
- Violations can result in the vehicle being towed at the owner's expense.
- First Offense – Loss of driving privilege for one week.
Second Offense – Loss of driving privilege for two weeks.
Third Offense – Loss of driving privilege for the remainder of the school year

Serious violations (Example – Reckless Driving) could result in prosecution.

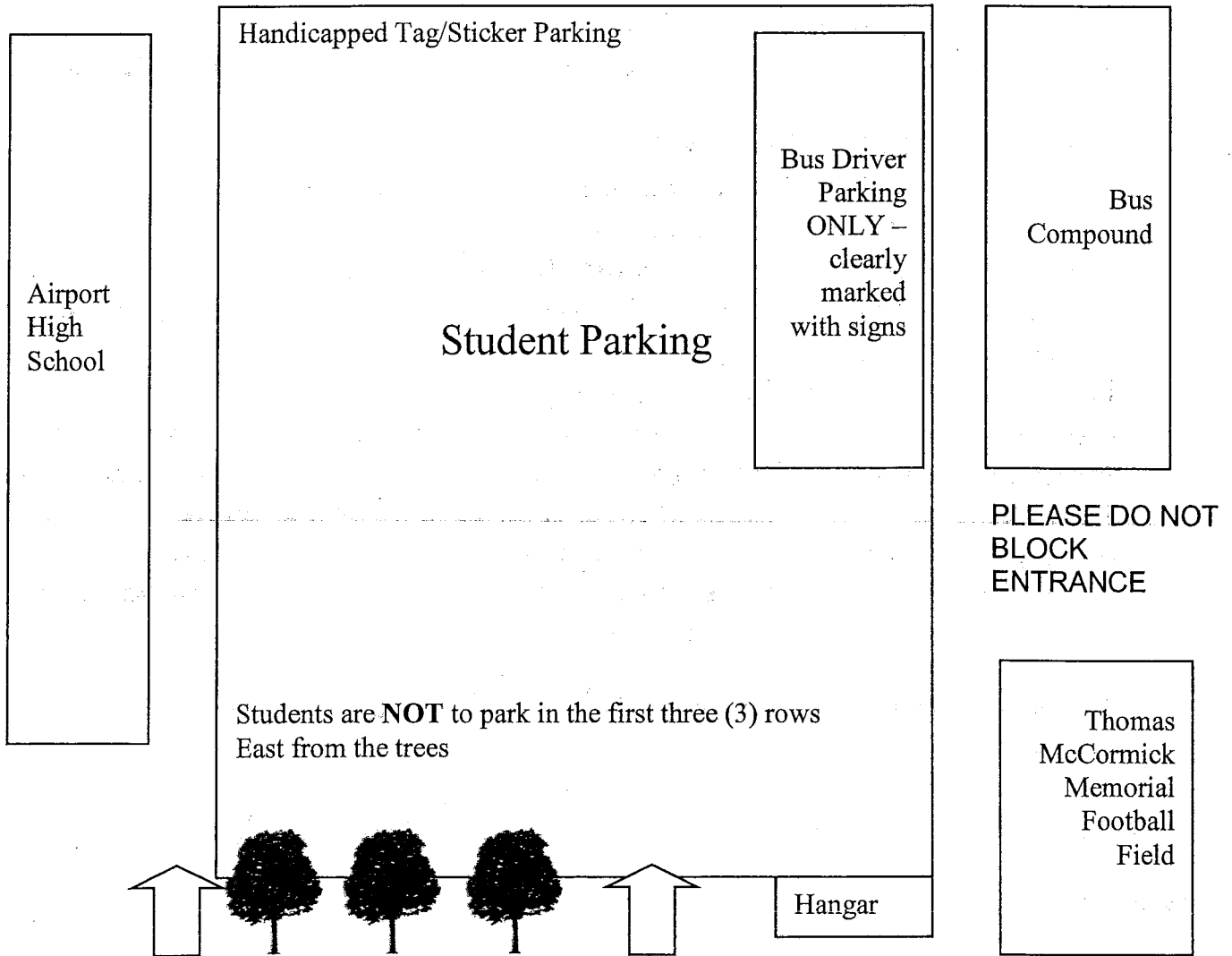

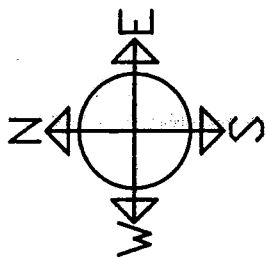


PLEASE DO NOT
